

HOME SERVICE FOR ROSH HASHANAH AND YOM KIPPUR



The candles are lit before the blessing is recited. First blessing is for Rosh Hashanah. Rosh Hashanah is on Shabbat this year. The second blessing is for Yom Kippur (not on Shabbat). Please note that on Yom Kippur, the candles are lit at the end of the mail, initiate the fast.
